### Immediate Inventory of MSCF Processors Removed by Mod Note 139

Modification Note 139 required each WSR-88D site to return the MSCF processor being replaced to the NRC for proper disposition. With the exception of 1 site, all have reported Modification Note 139 completed in EMRS. However, there have been only 12 MSCF processors returned to the NRC. There are 67 MSCF that are still under the local accountable property custody of the WFO. There are another 69 MSCF that were transferred to custodial account 54018M042 during the attempt to consolidate all WSR-88D elements under one custodial area. This EMRS notice concerns only the 57 MSCF on the spreadsheet (see link below) that are listed under 54018M042, but were not returned to NRC as instructed by Mod Note 139.

The annual inventory of all accountable property within NOAA has begun. Since these MSCF are no longer part of the WSR-88D baseline, a “declarative resolution” cannot be used to inventory them. This means that each MSCF that is on this spreadsheet must be accounted for in a “physical inventory”. It is not possible for the property custodian to travel to 57 different radar sites to physically site these assets. As a result, each person listed as the “Current User” for a particular MSCF is being asked to certify that their WFO is still in possession of their old MSCF processor. An email to [james.m.williams@noaa.gov](mailto:james.m.williams@noaa.gov) from the individual listed as the “Current User” only will satisfy the inventory requirement. The email must contain the CD number and location of the asset in question at a minimum. I must either receive a certification for each asset or list it as “unaccounted for” in the inventory. The inventory must be complete by April 30. Please do not delay in providing this information. This process is much simpler than a Board of Review by the PPMB.

Please do not attempt to notify the ROC Hotline with this info. Please do not ship your old MSCF to the NRC. Retain it on site until you receive further instruction.
